What we do		
How does General Motors Insurance protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.	
How does General Motors Insurance collect my personal information?	 We collect your personal information, for example, when you apply for insurance or pay insurance premiums file an insurance claim or give us your contact information show us your Driver's License We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies. 	
Why can't I limit all sharing?	 Federal law gives you the right to limit only sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness affiliates from using your information to market to you sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.	
	 Our affiliates include companies with an "AmeriCredit," "GM Financial", "Mode," "GM," "General Motors," or "OnStar" name; financial companies such as ACAR Leasing Ltd.; and nonfinancial companies with a "Cruise" name. 	
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.	
	 Nonaffiliates we share with can include auto dealers, insurance companies, and marketers. 	
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.	
	 Our joint marketing partners include financial service providers and insurance companies. 	

Other important information

For Vermont Customers: We will not disclose information about your creditworthiness to our affiliates and will not disclose your personal information, financial information, credit report, or health information to nonaffiliated third parties to market to you, other than as permitted by Vermont law, unless you authorize us to make those disclosures.

California Residents: We will limit sharing to the extent required by California law, which may differ from the practices described in this notice.
